240 patient admissions



42.6 days = average length of stay; 10,215 total patient-days of care



Most common illnesses: HIV or AIDS; cancer; organ failure including liver, kidney, and heart diseases; skin diseases including frostbite, ulcerations, and gangrene; respiratory diseases; burns, fractures, and wounds from accidents and assaults; hepatitis C; diabetes; hypertension; and mental health diagnoses




