### PATIENTS



**240** patient admissions



**42.6** days = average length of stay; **10,215** total patient-days of care



**Most common illnesses:** HIV or AIDS; cancer; organ failure including liver, kidney, and heart diseases; skin diseases including frostbite, ulcerations, and gangrene; respiratory diseases; burns, fractures, and wounds from accidents and assaults; hepatitis C; diabetes; hypertension; and mental health diagnoses

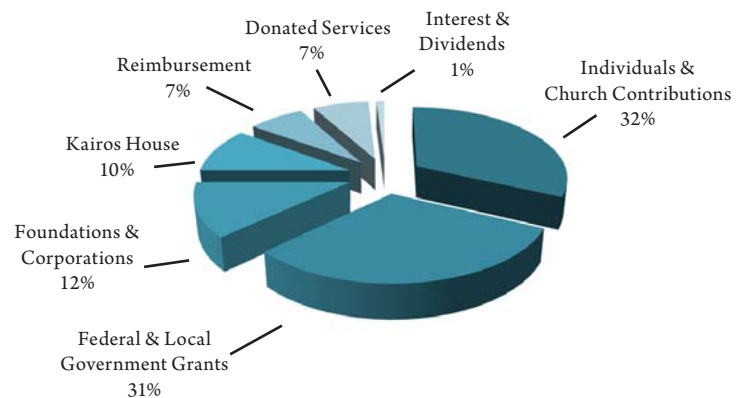

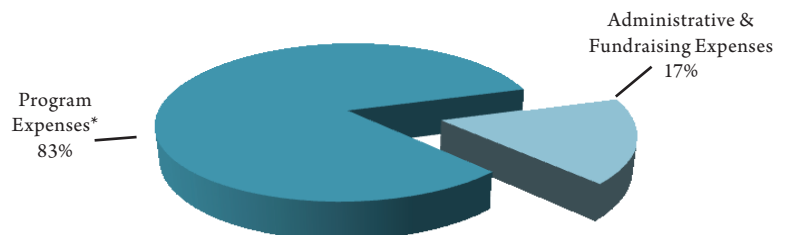
